COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES – April 28, 2009 – 5:30 P.M.  
420 NORTH BRIDGE, SUITE A, ST. ANTHONY, ID, CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS*

**PRESENT:** Mayor Garth Rose, Councilmembers Woody Andersen, Rod Willmore, Bryan Fullmer, Bryant Biorn, Bryan Stoddard and Elva Powell.

**ALSO PRESENT:** City Attorney Bill Forsberg, Public Works Superintendent Scott Butigan, City Clerk/Treasurer Patty Parkinson, and approximately three interested citizens.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Rose at 5:30 p.m.

**PLEDGE ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG** was led by Elva Powell.

**GENERAL BUSINESS**

**Safe Route To School Bid Award** – Mayor Rose began by reviewing that the bids were opened and read last Wednesday, April 22, 2009 at 6 p.m. Paul Snarr was present from Schiess & Associates and Mayor asked that Snarr go ahead and announce the winning bidder. Snarr handed out to council a memo from the Idaho Transportation Department regarding the authorization for the award to Depatco. The engineer’s estimated cost was \$108,000 and since Depatco’s bid came in at 70% ITD needed to authorize awarding it at a lower amount. The memo from ITD said that the project was reviewed and the award to Depatco at 70% of the engineer’s estimate was authorized. Snarr reviewed the bids and then said the award goes to Depatco at \$76,072. Attorney Forsberg asked if Schiess & Associates have verified their public works licensing and that it is good for this amount of money. Snarr said that it is good. Forsberg then asked the Clerk if she had received any objection to the bidding documents or bidding procedure prior to the 48 hours before the bids were opened. The Clerk said she had not. A motion to award the Safe Route To School Bid to Depatco at \$76,072 was made by Councilmember Andersen and seconded by Councilmember Powell. All council members approved.

There being no further business to come before the Council the meeting was adjourned at 5:35 p.m. by Mayor Garth Rose.
