GENERAL BUSINESS


Approval of 2010 Retail Alcoholic Beverage Licenses – Mayor Rose reported that this meeting is being held for three businesses in town that need to have council approve their alcohol licenses before 12 p.m. tonight. The licenses that need approval are Spurs and Spokes Saloon, RJ's Shell, Bridge Street Station and Star Bar. Mayor Rose said that next year council may not hold a special meeting for approval of late licenses. Clerk Parkinson reported that Silver Horseshoe Bar and Grill did not complete an application or pay their fees.
