The meeting was called to order by Mayor Rose at 5:30 p.m.

GENERAL BUSINESS

Silver Horseshoe Alcohol License – A motion to approve the alcohol license for the Silver Horseshoe was made by Councilmember Fullmer. Councilmember Stoddard asked if there were any legal issues. Attorney Forsberg asked if there were pending felony charges that would disqualify Marsha Wilson. Marsha Wilson said they were pending. Forsberg said pending felony charges do not disqualify one from obtaining an alcohol license. If Wilson was later convicted of those felony charges then that may be something council will have to look at. Forsberg said there is nothing on record that would stop the council from approving the license. Councilmember Biorn seconded the motion. All council members were in favor. Motion passed 6-0.
