SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

PRESENT: Mayor Neils Thueson, Council Members Tom Erickson, Lisa Haeberle, Rick Hill and Russ Rubert.

Mayor Neils Thueson called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

GENERAL BUSINESS

Approval of the 2014/2015 Liquor Licenses – Clerk Parkinson reported the city has 10 liquor licenses which need approval. They are BJ's Corner, Bottlestop, Broulim's, Dusty's Pitstop, El Jaliciense, Maverik, RJ's Exxon, Spurs & Spokes, Star Bar and Fongs. All have paid their required fees, completed their applications and provided copies of their State and County Licenses. Parkinson has checked with Chief of Police Harris who indicated there have been no problems in the past year with any of the businesses. Councilmember Rubert wanted to know why there were different amounts paid by different businesses. Parkinson explained it depends on the type of alcohol each business sells. Some sell hard liquor and other it's just beer and wine or beer only. A motion to approve all 10 businesses' alcohol licenses was made by Councilmember Rubert and seconded by Councilmember Haeberle. All council members present were in favor. Motion passed 4-0.

There being no further business to come before the Council the meeting was adjourned at approximately 9:10 a.m. by Mayor Thueson.
