**Fisherman's Breakfast, The Tradition Continues**

ST. ANTHONY – Ted Fronk, Brett Mackert and Harry Halkar, general chairmen of the Free Fisherman's Breakfast Committee, cordially invite you to the annual Free Fisherman's Breakfast set for May 28 in St. Anthony. This will be the **55th** year for the Breakfast which is always held on the Friday before the opening of the general fishing season. The fishing season opens on the Saturday before Memorial Day and marks the unofficial beginning to the summer recreation season. You are invited to kick off your weekend in St. Anthony with a hearty free breakfast at Clyde Keefer Memorial Park on the Henry's Fork of the Snake River. The chow line opens at 6 a.m. and breakfast is served until 1 p.m.

Equipment is being cleaned and repaired, the park will be spruced up, and plans are being made for booths and activities to entertain visitors. The program this year will be run by Ted Austin in conjunction with this Q102 FM radio broadcast from the park. Austin will emcee the noon program, which begins at 11 a.m. with the posting of the colors and the playing of the national anthem.

Visitors will get more than just a free breakfast of pancakes, sausage, hash browns and a beverage. They will be participating in a tradition that has been perpetuated over five decades by an army of dedicated volunteers who spend hours getting ready for and cleaning up after thousands of hungry breakfast goers. Many of the attendees are repeat visitors who have made attendance at the Breakfast a tradition of their own.

Again, the general chairmen of the breakfast invite you to join us in St. Anthony for the Free Fisherman's Breakfast between 6 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Friday, May 28.
