

City of St Anthony Disaster Declaration

WHEREAS, there is threat to life and property in the city of **ST ANTHONY**, as the result of high water on local rivers, canals and streams which has occurred on June 8th, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the resulting high water on local rivers, canals and streams is threatening structures, roadways, infrastructures, public utilities, and

WHEREAS, a disaster emergency as defined in Section 46-1002, Idaho Code, is in existence in the city of **ST ANTHONY**, due to the imminent threat to life and property created by high water and

WHEREAS, Section 46-1011, Idaho Code, authorizes the Mayor of the city of **ST ANTHONY**, Idaho to declare a disaster emergency to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance, thereunder;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, and declared by the Mayor of the city of **ST ANTHONY**, as follows:

1. A disaster emergency is hereby declared to exist within the city of **ST ANTHONY**, created by high water, creating an imminent threat to life and property and
2. These conditions require the activation of the response and recovery aspects of all applicable local disaster emergency plans and
3. Such disaster may require State emergency assistance to supplement local efforts to protect, rehabilitate, and replace public property and to provide a coordinated multi-agency effort to mitigate, avert and lessen the threat and impact of the disaster.

Declared this 8th day of June, 2011, by Mayor Neils Thueson of the city of **ST ANTHONY** at 0700 hrs.
