The first full month of our new garbage collection system is over. The changeover has gone very well. We've had some missed collections for which we apologize. PSI has been very good to work with. Please remember to remove carts from the street on the day of collection. Also, PSI can only pickup the blue carts. Other garbage containers are not suitable for this system.

Hoffco construction has shut down construction on phase II sewer work for 90 days. Activity on this project will resume about March 15th, 2006.

The City has submitted a grant to begin developing an industrial park on city owned property east of the airport. If successful, Summit Truss Manufacturing will build a new plant which will provide up to 30 jobs. Other developers have also expressed an interest in locating there.
