Don't panic - St. Anthony Ordinance # 2007-1 commonly called "The Curfew Ordinance"

is now city law. Will we see any big changes in St. Anthony? Most of us, NO!! The ordinance is designed to solve problems caused by a few. You the parents will be the primary "enforcer" of this ordinance. Just so every one knows, the curfew hours are as follows: Under 16 years old - 11:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m. 16 and 17 year olds, 12:30 a.m. - 5:00 a.m. There are some exceptions to these times such as a school, or church activity, within 50 feet of the minor's residence, doing an errand

for parents, when accompanied by parents and a few others.

Initially, our officers will give warnings. Violations of this ordinance are infractions. Upon first conviction, the fine is not to exceed \$50.00. If another conviction occurs within 3 years the fine is not to exceed \$300.00. Parents can be found guilty of an infraction also. We have good kids and good parents in St. Anthony. Therefore I expect the violations to be few. This is a good tool for our police department and appears to have the support of a large majority of our citizens.
