



## Words from Mayor Beck

We opened bids for the 12<sup>th</sup> west street project on June 30<sup>th</sup>. H-K contractors were the low bidders and we have awarded the contract to them. Their bid will allow us to do more work than originally planned with the grant money. An additional 300 – 400 feet of 12<sup>th</sup> west, south of the canal will be rebuilt.

It also appears that we will be receiving grant money to rebuild west Main

Street. This money will be available in 2013.

We also have good news to report about the cost of work needing done on the rest of our city streets. The cost estimates are much, much lower than originally estimated. We will be preparing this information for public meetings in the near future.

## Department Reports

### Police and Fire

All-terrain vehicles (ATV) or off-road vehicles are not generally allowed on city streets unless they are registered, with a license plate displayed. This includes four-wheelers or motorcycles. There are no designated in-city routes to get from your house to a country road or trail. County road restrictions also apply to these vehicles. A licensed driver with a street-legal, licensed vehicle may drive on city streets. Helmets are required for those under 18 as drivers or passengers. Exceptions to licensed vehicles have included snow removal or farm-type activities. Bicycle thefts continue to occur from yards and public places. We recommend you write down your serial number and use a lock.

### Compliance

Please be sure to take extra care of your dogs during the upcoming celebrations. Fire works can cause distress and your pet may run off looking for someplace safe to hide. Getting city tags will insure that your pets are returned safely.

### Parks and Recreation
