## **DOOR TO DOOR SURVEYORS COMING!**

**We have received a grant offer of approximately \$537,000 from the federal government to conduct the Phase III Wastewater System Improvements. We can apply for a grant from the State for \$500,000. The State grant is to be used as the match requirement to receive the federal grant. In order to establish our eligibility for the grants we must conduct a confidential survey throughout the residential community in St. Anthony.**

**The door-to-door survey is COMPLETELY CONFIDENTIAL and is being conducted by an independent group during the week of July 6, 2009.**

**Please assist the survey team by completing your confidential survey and placing it in the envelope for the surveyor. The team will compile the results and present them in a report to the City and to the potential granting agency. No identifying information will be collected.**
