Above is an overview of the City's budget for the third quarter of the fiscal year. 75% of the year has passed and most departments and funds are well within or under their budgeted expenditures. As of today, the Wastewater Phase III Project is completed, except for some small clean up items. Final payments to the contractor are still pending finalization and will be made next quarter. ## Zoning Permits and Building Permits



City Code requires a Zoning Permit for anyone doing any erection, construction, extension, enlargement, moving, removing, converting, or demolishing of any building, residence or structure in the city. This includes decks and fences. A Zoning Permit can be purchased at City Hall, 420 N. Bridge, Suite A. Permits are normally \$25 for everything except for fences. A Zoning Permit for a fence is normally \$10. Purchasing a permit will ensure you are correctly zoned for what you are planning to do. Once the Zoning Permit is purchase a Building Permit can then be obtained from Fremont County Planning and Building. If you hire a contractor to build an addition, deck or fence, make sure they are aware of the requirements of a Zoning and Building Permit before they begin the job.


