

ORDINANCE 2012-4

2013 FISCAL YEAR FINAL APPROPRIATION BUDGET

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2012, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$5,332,148 TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF ST. ANTHONY FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR, AUTHORIZING A LEVY OF A SUFFICIENT TAX UPON THE TAXABLE PROPERTY AND SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATION IS MADE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of St. Anthony, Fremont County, Idaho:

Section 1: That the sum of \$5,332,148 be, and the same is appropriated to defray the necessary expenditures and liabilities of the City of St. Anthony, Fremont County, Idaho, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2012.

Section 2: The objects and purposes for which such appropriation is made, and the amount of each object and purpose is as follows:

Section 3: That a general tax levy on all taxable property within the City of St. Anthony be levied in and amount allowed by law for the general purposes for said City, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2012.

Section 4: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Standard Journal, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of St. Anthony, and the official newspaper of the City.

PASSED under suspension of rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and duly enacted an Ordinance of the City of St. Anthony, Fremont County, Idaho, at a convened meeting of the City of St. Anthony City Council held on the 9th day of August, 2012.
