

Ordinance No. 2016-03

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION TITLE 6, SECTION 6.08.020 OF THE ST. ANTHONY CITY CODE, AMENDING SAID SECTION TO PROVIDE THAT A DOG LICENSE BE VALID FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR, AND ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.**

WHEREAS, The Mayor and City Council find it to be in the best interests of the City to limit the term of a dog license to one year to better administer and enforce the City's dog ordinances.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. ANTHONY, IDAHO THAT TITLE 6, SECTION 6.08.020 OF THE ST. ANTHONY CITY CODE BE AND HEREBY IS AMENDED TO PROVIDE A DOG LICENSE SHALL BE VALID FOR ONE YEAR, AS FOLLOWS:

6.08.020 - License—Required—Address change—Ownership transfer.

It is unlawful for any owner to harbor, keep or have in charge an unlicensed dog over four months of age within the city limits. The owner shall obtain a license from the city clerk for each dog. These licenses shall be valid for ~~the life of the animal~~ one year, on condition that the owner provides appropriate change of address or change of owner notification to the clerk as these events occur. Failure to provide address or ownership change notification to the clerk within thirty days of such change will be punishable by a fine as set forth in Appendix 1. It shall be the duty of the clerk to issue a license to the person bearing the same number as the number worn on the collar of the dog as provided in Section 6.08.040. The license shall give the date of issuance, the name and address of the person to whom issued and the name and sex of the dog. The clerk shall furnish with each license a metal tag which shall be stamped with the number to correspond with the number of the license and the year for which it is issued. The fine for not having a license for a dog is set forth in Appendix 1. The provisions of this section shall not apply to any person visiting the city for a period not exceeding thirty days and owning or possessing a dog currently licensed and bearing the license issued by another licensing authority.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect 30 days after its passage and publication, all as provided by law.
