

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-3

A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE SPEED LIMIT ON A PORTION OF THE SOUTH YELLOWSTONE HIGHWAY; PROVIDING FOR CROSSWALKS AND WARNING SIGNS TO BE INSTALLED ON WEST 7TH SOUTH STREET; ESTABLISHING A SCHOOL ZONE SPEED LIMIT, AND PROVIDING FOR CROSSWALKS AND SIGNS ON 8TH SOUTH STREET; DESIGNATING CERTAIN STREETS TO BE STOP OR YIELD STREETS AND PROVIDING FOR SIGNS TO BE PLACED ON THOSE STREETS; AND, ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. ANTHONY, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The speed limit on the South Yellowstone Highway from the canal by Targhee Trailer to the Bottle Stop corner is hereby amended from 45 miles per hour to 30 miles per hour.

2. Crosswalks and signs warning drivers to the east and west of the crosswalks shall be installed across West 7th South where it intersects with North 4th West.

3. The speed limit on West 8th South Street is hereby amended to 20 miles per hour, and said street shall be designated as a school zone. Crosswalks and signs warning drivers on either side of the crosswalks shall be installed across West 8th South where it intersects with North 4th West.

4. Those cross streets intersecting with East Main Street shall be signed so as to require vehicles to stop before crossing or traveling onto East Main Street.

5. Those cross streets intersecting with East First North Street shall be signed so as to require vehicles to yield before crossing or traveling onto East First North.

6. Those cross streets intersecting with East Second North Street shall be signed so as to require vehicles to yield before crossing or traveling onto East Second North.

7. Those cross streets intersecting with East Third North Street shall be signed so as to require vehicles to yield before crossing or traveling onto East Third North.

8. Those cross streets intersecting with East Fourth North Street shall be signed so as to require vehicles to stop before crossing or traveling onto East Fourth North.

9. Those cross streets intersecting from the East with North

Bridge Street shall be signed so as to require vehicles to stop before crossing or traveling onto North Bridge Street.

10. East First North Street where it intersects with North Sixth East shall be signed so as to require vehicles to stop before crossing or traveling onto North Sixth East.

11. East Second North Street where it intersects with North Sixth East shall be signed so as to require vehicles to stop before crossing or traveling onto East Second North.

12. East Fifth North Street where it intersects with North Third East shall be signed so as to require vehicles to stop before crossing or traveling onto North Third East.

13. Those cross streets intersecting with North Third East North of the U.S. Highway 191 Business Loop, there known as the Junk Yard Road shall be signed so as to require vehicles to stop before crossing or traveling onto the Junk Yard Road.

14. Those cross streets intersecting with the U.S. Highway 191 Business Loop shall be signed so as to require vehicles to stop before crossing or traveling onto U.S. Highway 191 Business Loop.


15. Those cross streets intersecting with Radio Road shall be signed so as to require vehicles to stop before crossing or traveling onto Radio Road.

16. South Fifth West Street where it intersects with West Eighth South Street and West Seventh South Street, shall be signed so as to require vehicles to stop before crossing or traveling onto West Eighth South Street and West Seventh South Street.

17. The Public Works Superintendent shall supervise installation of the appropriate signs and markers.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and publication.
