A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. ANTHONY SETTING FORTH A POLICY ALLOWING POLICE OFFICERS UPON RETIREMENT FROM THE CITY TO BE GIVEN THEIR DUTY WEAPON.


WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desires to reward retiring police officers for their years of dedicated service to the City of St. Anthony;

WHEREAS, if the retiring officer shall have served with the City for a minimum of ten years, and shall be in good standing upon retirement;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council understand the continued risks, even in retirement, to individuals having been involved in law enforcement, and wishes to see retired officers carry a firearm in compliance with H.R. 218 Law Enforcement Officers' Safety Act;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of St. Anthony, effective August 1, 2005, Police Officers retiring from the City of St. Anthony shall be awarded their duty weapon on their date of retirement.
