

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-6

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ST. ANTHONY CITY UTILITY SECURITY DEPOSIT, AND ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

Whereas, the City of St. Anthony provides vital public services of water, sewer and garbage to its residents, which services are solely provided by utility payments by recipients of those services; and

Whereas, a disproportionate number of residents are delinquent on payment of utility bills; and

Whereas, delinquent accounts require approximately two months lag time between delinquency and shutting off accounts; and

Whereas, the non-payment of utility bills by some city residents places an unfair burden on other residents to pay for the utility services, NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. ANTHONY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following fees are hereby established for the City of St. Anthony Utilities Department:

A. A security deposit shall be assessed on every new account, which deposit shall be determined by averaging the last twelve (12) months utilities bills on that property, which amount shall include water, sewer and garbage, and multiplying that amount by two (2), so as to provide for a security deposit of two (2) months average utility charges for that property.

B. On new accounts for which there is no adequate history from which to determine a two months average, the security deposit shall be \$140.00.

2. Any fees not specifically modified herein, shall be as now otherwise established.


3. This resolution shall be in full force and effect 30 days following its passage.
