


RESOLUTION NO 2008- 1

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2005-9 CHANGING THE STRUCTURE OF THE SYSTEM DEVELOPMENT CHARGE FOR ANY PERSON OR PARTY DESIRING TO HOOK UP A ONE FAMILY RESIDENCE TO THE CITY WATER SYSTEM, AND TO HOOK UP A ONE FAMILY RESIDENCE OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS TO THE CITY WATER SYSTEM.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. ANTHONY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Fees previously referred to as Hook Up Fees shall now be referred to as System Development Charges.
2. Pursuant to St. Anthony Municipal Code Section 13.08.040, the following fees are hereby established for System Development Charges for the St. Anthony City Water system.
 - A. For new connections the System Development Charge shall be \$1,870 per connection on all lines up to one inch in size, plus the actual out of pocket costs to the city, including, but not limited to compaction testing, a mainline tap, corporation-stop galvanized gooseneck, meter, meter box and accessories.
 - B. For all new connections 1 ½ inches in size the System Development Charge shall be at 2 times the 1 inch rate, and 2 inches at 3.20 times the 1 inch rate. For any connection 3 inches or more in size, the fee shall be determined based on current water study data, with the advice of the city engineer, and with the approval of the city council.
3. This resolution shall be effective as of the date of passage.
