

**CITY OF ST. ANTHONY
RESOLUTION NO. 2010-2**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE POSTING OF
SIGNS AT THE ENTRANCES OF CITY OWNED PARKING LOTS
TO REGULATE OVERNIGHT PARKING

WHEREAS, the City owns and operates several public parking lots in the downtown area, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is appropriate to regulate overnight parking in those lots,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of St. Anthony, Idaho that signs be posted at the entrances to each of the City owned parking lots advising the public that there is no parking between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. except by permit. That the City Clerk is authorized to issue overnight parking permits to businesses, and residents of the downtown area so long as such parking does not unduly interfere with the City clearing the snow from the parking lots.

The Public Works Department is instructed to have the signs made and to erect them.
