

Resolution Establishing Base Charge for Unoccupied Property

Resolution # 2010-13A

THE CITY COUNCIL AND MAYOR HAVING FOUND THAT THE CITY SHOULD CHARGE PERSONS NOT ACTUALLY OCCUPYING IMPROVED REAL PROPERTY THE BASE CHARGE OF BOND PAYMENTS FOR WATER AND SEWER, ONLY, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:

Whenever improved real property having at least one hookup for sewer and water is proven to the satisfaction of the City Clerk to be unoccupied for at least one calendar month, the charge for each such calendar month shall be the base charge for sewer and water service for each hookup associated with the property as the City shall determine from time to time, which charge currently is \$18.00 per hookup.

Whenever the water remains on, application for this reduction must be made in advance and will be allowed subject to verification by the City.
