


BUSINESS LICENSING

Businesses will be receiving **renewals** for licensing shortly. Additionally, the back side of this newsletter is the application for Business Licensing. If you own or operate a business in the city of St. Anthony, including home based businesses, you need to apply or re-apply for a license before January 1, 2017. Please contact the city offices with any questions.

ANNUAL DOG LICENSING

In March the city council changed dog licensing to an annual registration. They also changed the fees for dog tags to \$5 for an altered (spayed or neutered) dog and \$10 for an unaltered dog. This pricing is less than what it used to be. There is also some special pricing for Senior Citizens and Guide dogs. That pricing is \$3. This begins January 1, 2017. The City will be having a **FREE** licensing week in January beginning January 3rd and ending on January 9th. If you have a dog tag now it will be obsolete in January. Each year the dog tag will be different in design and color. Please make sure you are following the city's new ordinance, 6.08.020, and pick up your new dog tag for 2017 at the city offices, 420 N Bridge St.

2016 REFLECTIONS

The city completed one of its largest street projects in many years. In addition to fog coating 20 miles of city streets West Main, from Bridge Street to 12th South, was completely reconstructed, including curb, gutter, sidewalks, and lights. Residents even received new mail boxes as required by the US Postal service. What did this cost you as a taxpayer? The city's portion was a little over \$200,000. The rest came from a federally funded grant awarded to the city in 2008. Had the city not been awarded this grant, those grant monies would have been spent somewhere else in the State of Idaho. We were very fortunate to receive this funding. The city cut back significantly to begin saving for their match portion. Each year, money was set aside to provide for the match for this project and going forward this amount will be used for street projects year after year. Residents can see the results of this fiscal responsibility in the streets we've chipped and sealed. Work will continue next summer as we continue to make St. Anthony look GREAT!
